The posting of Guest Teachers will be made in the schools as per existing vacancy at the time of engagement.

The undersigned reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of posts as per the requirement.

Interested candidates are required to apply on the Bio Data form (in Annexure –I) along with a set of Self attested copies of Academic Qualification Certificates with mark sheets, Experience Certificates (if any) to the District Welfare Officer, Rayagada by Speed Post /Registered Post only on or before 05.P.M of 10.09.2024. The application received after the due date will not be entertained. The Applicant should super scribe on the top of the Envelop as "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF AS ABOVE FOR GUEST TEACHER".

After scrutiny of the Certificates, the eligible candidates will be informed to attend the walk-in-interview to be taken up by a selection committee of Experts comprising of DWO, CI of Schools, DI of Schools, HM of the School and a subject Teacher through District website i.e http://Rayagada.odisha.gov.in to attend the interview. After the Walk-in-interview the selected candidates will also be intimated through District website for their engagement.

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The maximum age limit of disengagement for the guest faculty shall be 62 (Sixty two) and the retired teacher engaged as the guest faculty under the provision will be disengaged on attaining the age of 65 (Sixty five).

The duties, terms and conditions for the posts is hereunder:-

A-Duties and Responsibilities of Guest Faculty:

Teachers appointed as Guest Faculty will discharge the following duties:

- a) Teaching of concerned subject as per Syllabus.
- b) Timely correction of class and home assignments, test papers, projects etc.
- c) Setting of question papers for various tests and exams.
- d) Preparation of lesson plans and maintaining academic record of students.
- e) Preparing students for curricular/ co-curricular activities etc.
- f) Performing invigilation duty / evaluation work as and when assigned.
- g) Any other work as to be assigned by the Headmaster/Principal.

B-Terms and Conditions:-

- I. Guest teacher engaged would have no claim or right for appointment on a regular basis nor will they be a part of the cadre of teachers of SSD Deptt.
- II. Working hours and period of duration shall be as per the school time table.
- III. The engagement of these Guest teachers will automatically come to an end once a regular/ contractual teacher is appointed/ engaged against the vacant post or as and when the appropriate authority decides.
- IV. The Guest Teacher so engaged shall also be entrusted with correction and evaluation work of the concerned subject in the school and he/she will not be entitled for extra honorarium for such work.
- V. The performance of the teacher will be reviewed on regular basis. If any teacher is found to be non-performing or engaged in activities leading to misconduct he /she shall be disengaged by the appropriate authority under intimation to District Welfare Officer.
- VI. The Maximum age for Guest Teacher at the time of disengagement shall be Sixty Two (62) & the retired teacher engaged as Guest Teacher shall be disengaged on attaining the age of sixty five (65).
- VII. A Guest Teacher unauthorizedly remaining absent and not taking classes for a continuous period of 15 days or more deemed to be terminated and he/she shall never be entertained further.

C- Eligibility Criteria:-

- a) For Class I to VII Matric / +2 Arts / Science with minimum 50 % marks in aggregate with CT.
- b) For Class VIII to X BA/B.Sc with minimum 50 % marks in aggregate with B.Ed.
- c) Preference will be given to the retired teachers and candidates having teaching experience.



D- Honorarium:-

I. A Guest teacher will be paid Honorarium not exceeding Rs.12000/- in a month for elementary level and Honorarium not exceeding Rs.16000/- in a month for Secondary level and Higher Secondary Level.

Documents Required:-

- 1. Self-attested Xerox copies of all the certificates and mark sheets from HSC onwards along with the filled in application form (Annexure-I).
- 2. Two recent colour passport size photograph of the candidate, one is to be pasted on the application form and another one in separate envelop to be enclosed along with the documents.
- 3. If any candidate has experience in his/her concerned field or in any reputed institutions, the self attested certificate is to be enclosed along with the application.
- 4. One self attested identity and address proof of the candidate is to be submitted.
- 5. Self-attested, Xerox copy of Aadhaar card and front page Bank Passbook.
- 6. Valid Residence Certificate issued on or after **01.08.2019** must be produced along with application form.

Mode of Selection

- 1. Preference will be given to the retired teachers and candidates having teaching experience.
- 2. The entire selection procedure will be decided by the Selection Committee.
- **3.** The selection committee will select the candidates with reference to the eligibility criteria as mentioned in this notification and as per following norms:
 - a) 50% career weightage (50 marks) = 1^{st} div- 50 Marks, 2^{nd} div with minimum 50% marks 30 marks.
 - b) 30% teaching experience (30 marks) = 1 year -10 marks, 2 years -20 marks. 3 years and above- 30 marks
 - c) 20% interview <u>- 20 marks</u> Total -100 Marks

If, the aggregate percentage of marks secured by the candidate in his/her career (except CT/B.Ed) is less than 50%. He /She shall not be considered for appointment.

Ten (10) months of teaching experience should be treated as a year and 10 marks will be awarded for each year of experience with minimum limitation of 30 marks. Candidates having more than 3 years of experience will be limited to 30 marks.

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If the total marks scored by two or more candidates in computation of marks by selection committee get equal, candidates scoring higher percentage of marks in CT or B.Ed as the case may be will get preference.

- 4. Selected candidates will have to perform his/her duties by abiding all the rules and regulations of a residential school managed by ST & SC Dev. Deptt. Govt. of Odisha.
- 5. The undersigned reserves right to cancel the interview in part/ whole and disengage the candidature without prior notice or assigning any reason thereof.
- 6. No T.A/D.A will be given for attending this interview.
