4. Submission of filled application form shall commence from **date of advertisement and will close at 1700h on 28 Feb 2025**.

5. **Eligibility Criteria**.

(a) **Direct Entry Havildar**. Terms and Conditions for Enrolment as Direct Entry Havildars. The broad terms and conditions as applicable to these personnel are given in the succeeding paragraphs:-

(i) **Age**.

(aa) The age limit for enrolment will be from 17 ½ to 25 years should have completed 17 ½ on the first day of enrolment period and must have not crossed 25 yrs on the last day of enrolment period.

(ab) **Date of Birth Block**. Candidates born between **31 Mar 2000** to **01 Apr 2007** (both dates inclusive) are eligible to apply.

(iv) **Sports Achievements**. The selection will be made from out of those who have represented as under in any of the sports and games specified as above :-

(aa) Individual should be a **Medalist** at Junior/ Senior level by representing State in National competitions or have represented Country at International level (**Indl event**).

(ab) Individual should have represented a State or Country in National or International competitions at Junior/ Senior level (**Team event**).

(ac) Individual should be a **Medalist** in Khelo India Games & Khelo India Youth Games & Khelo India university games.

(b) **Direct Entry Naib Subedar**. Terms and Conditions for Enrolment for Direct Entry Naib Subedar. The broad terms and conditions as applicable to these personnel are given in the succeeding paragraphs:-

(i) The age limit for enrolment will be from 17 ½ to 25 years should have completed 17 ½ on the first day of enrolment period and must have not crossed 25 yrs on the last day of enrolment period.

(ii) **Date of Birth Block**. Candidates born between **31 Mar 2000** to **01 Apr 2007** (both dates inclusive) are eligible to apply.

7. **Pay & Allowances/ Pension.**

(a) **Pay and Allowances.** Pay & allowances for direct entry Havildar and Naib Subedar shall be same as applicable to existing Regular Serving Personnel of Indian Army as per provision of Army pay Rules, 2017 and amendments thereon.

(c) **CSD Facilities.** CSD facilities to such persons will be applicable as per the provision contained in AO 2/2006 QMG (amended from time to time)

12. **Employability & Liability for Service.**

(a) Individual enrolled under this entry will be liable for service in any part of the world and assigned any duty in organisational interest, as decided from time to time by the IHQ of MoD (Army).

18. **Mandatory Medical Standards**

(a) Medical examination of candidates who qualify in Physical Fitness Test, Physical Standards Test & Skill Test will be conducted by Army Medical Team at the trials site as per Army Medical standards and policy in vogue on the subject issue.

(b) Unfit candidates will be referred to MH for specialist review. Candidates to report designated Military Hospital within 05 days from referral and review medical exam to be completed by Military Hospital within 07 days as per policy.

(c) The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial med examination, review medical examination and med examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Army standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or appeal or re-review after the review medical examination.

(d) Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in Indian Army.

19. **Consumption of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance (NDPS)**. 27. **Training.** The initial training for the sportsperson will be conducted at designated Regimental Centre followed by Professional training in the allotted trade in various Army Training Establishment. Branch/ Trade will be allocated as per the requirement of Service.
28. **Discharge as Unsuitable.** Havildar & Naib Subedar are liable to be discharged as UNSUITABLE due to unsatisfactory performance at any time during the training.
29. **Probationary Period.** All sportsmen enrolled under this scheme will be placed under a probationary period of 3 years. Havildar & Naib Subedar entries are liable to be discharged if sports performance does not improve to expected levels in the probationary period of three yrs.

### **SELECTION PROCEDURE**

30. The application format is given at the end of this advertisement. The selection procedure is as follows:-
